- Emphasis on learning and developing basketball skills
- Games scored and refereed
- Will try to honor player requests to play together
- Trophies for all players

GRADES 3 – HIGH SCHOOL

- Girls and Boys play in separate divisions
- Competitive with age appropriate rules
- All players drafted onto teams and must attend evaluations

TRAVEL TEAMS

- Boys in 4th – 8th grades and Girls 5th – 8th grades eligible to try out
- Players must register and attend their Intramural evaluations
